DARBIE - (Female) Darbie is the protagonist of the doll story and an eternal optimist. She is sweet-natured, perceptive, complex, and intelligent and cares deeply about her family, friends, fashion, and Ben. Even though she is only a teen she has succeeded at almost every career choice.

Ben - (Male) Has a heart of gold but things only go his way because of good luck; not good planning. He is naive but thinks he has everything all figured out. He adores Darbie, his 'good ideas', and brushing his hair or looking in the mirror.

Fashionista Ben - (M) Fashion is the language he speaks. He is dramatic, over the top, and funny. A likable character that provides comic relief with campy humor.

Stacie - (F) A smart and sassy realist. She addresses the audience directly showcasing her dry humor but rarely shows her sarcasm to her sisters. She stays sharp and level-headed except when it comes to Ben.

Skippy -(F) A likable character that goes with the flow but has the typical emotions of a pre-teen/teenager. She feels confident one minute but freaks out the next.

Chelsea 1, Chelsea 2, Chelsea 3 - (F) Triplets, fun, rambunctious, and adorable. Often hold hands, sometimes fight, play games and they love a good prank.

Rochelle - (F) The doll antagonist of the story, life is never dull when Rochelle walks into a room. She is in a self-inflicted and never-ending battle with Darbie but never seems to win. She pronounces words with her own accent and has a flair for the dramatics. Full of hilarious comebacks and put downs. Has a twin named Ryan.

Ryan- (M/F)Rochelle's twin brother or sister and Rochelle's sidekick that follows whatever Rochelle tells them to do.

Reagan-(M/F) Friend of Rochelle and Ryan, caddy and petty.

Tadd - (M) Little brother of Ben that was discontinued and cast aside. Looks up to his big brother.

Kelly-(F) Disheveled and discontinued little sister.

Z- (M/F) Professional photographer to the stars and the doll family.

Midge - (F) Naive, old fashioned, stuck in the 1950-1960ssnorts when laughs. A loveable character brings a fresh and often funny point of view. Wants to have a boyfriend but has been stuck with only Kelly and Tadd for many years.

Alexia the computer- (M/F) Sounds like a computer and adds interest to the real-life mean girls scenes.

FLEXIBLE NUMBER OF PARTS HERE

Storytellers/Fangirls and Fanboys-(M/F) Flexible lines and number of characters - Sloane, Parker, and Blake (script can include Storytellers Lakelyn, Jocelyn, Darren, Everly, Kenna, Gigi) The glue that holds this story together. The words they speak are poetic and thoughtful. Characters that give a story-like feel to the play. Director note: all storyteller lines can be customized to fit the production and the number of actors. Theater director maintains control as to how lines/parts can be distributed as the storyteller parts are meant to be flexible. Director is welcome to rename any storytellers.

Doll Newscasters Patti Ann, Axel Rae, and Lily Lane (M/F) Break the news of the possible discontinuation of Darbie Dolls franchise. Provide theatrical and lively commentary on their predicament and the future.

Madison - (F) Queen bee of the third-grade mean girls of Sparkle City. She is spoiled, self-absorbed, and too grown up. Worried more about the future than being a kid. Top Darbie Doll and social media influencer.

Ivy - (F) The nicest of the mean girls, a loyal friend even when she is treated poorly by the other girls. Desperately trying to fit in. Her favorite hobby is face masks and making social media videos.

Piper - (F) Mean girl that acts like a teenager.


Emerald - (F) Sell, Sell, Sell CEO, (Madison's mom), Type A overachiever who forgets to put her daughter's happiness and childhood first.

TVT

I assume this isn't...the after-school mock trial club meeting

MADISON

Yep, wrong room just kids wasting time

IVY

Playing dolls like babies.

STORYTELLER JOCELYN

How rude!

STORYTELLER PARKER AND MACY

(Cover their face like they are crying)

PIPER

We accomplish more in 5 minutes than you, you, you, and you do in five years. Let's get out of here.

STORYTELLER SLOANE

(Clap, clap, clap)

Attention Please, Madison pretends to like Darbies just to get more followers

STORYTELLER LAKELYN

What a fake

STORYTELLER PARKER

Gross, she acts like she's 25

STORYTELLER BLAKE

And she's only 9

STORYTELLER JOCELYN

And that Ivy and Piper just do whatever she says...

STORYTELLER SLOANE

All her mom cares about are designer colleges

STORYTELLER PARKER

The smart schools

STORYTELLER DARREN

I know!

STORYTELLER SLOANE

Darren, I told you to go wait in the car with mom

(Said to her younger brother)

ALL STORYTELLERS

(Motion for Darren to leave)

STORYTELLER SLOANE

She doesn't even like competitive volleyball

STORYTELLER LAKELYN

but her mom forces her to do it

STORYTELLER SLOANE

Welcome to the first meeting of ...

ALL STORYTELLERS

the Darbie Fan Club!

STORYTELLER EVERLY

(Runs in)

Sorry I'm late... closet malfunction...

STORYTELLER PARKER

Fashion First!

ALL STORYTELLERS

(All hands in circle, then hands up) 1,2,3, we love Darbies!

STORYTELLER PARKER

I love them more

STORYTELLER KENNA

No, I do

STORYTELLER GIGI

I do!

MACY

I love them to the moon and back and back again

STORYTELLER EVERLY

I love them times infinity

STORYTELLER JOCELYN

Obviously I love them the most. My ensemble depicts the Darbie Fashion Style. It's like I'm actually Darbie...

STORYTELLER PARKER

I have the shirt that says I'm her biggest fan...

(Turns around and shows back of shirt)

it's settled

ALL DARBIE DOLLS

(Darbie Dolls line up on runway and walk down the runway as the storytellers talk about them, each doll should be ready and in line-starts walking when announced)

STORYTELLER SLOANE

(Holds up doll everyone tries to grab it out of her hands)

STORYTELLER SLOANE (CONT'D)

Darbie is sweet, smart...

STORYTELLER GIGI

And complex

STORYTELLER KENNA

She's so pretty

STORYTELLER EVERLY

She loves her sisters and her boyfriend

STORYTELLER LAKELYN

Ben has a heart of gold

ALL STORYTELLERS

(In love)

Ahhhh!

STORYTELLER PARKER

And he can be clueless...

STORYTELLER SLOANE

but who cares cause he's so handsome

STORYTELLER EVERLY

Fashionista Ben has the best clothes

STORYTELLER SLOANE

Yeah his style is A-maze-ing

STORYTELLER PARKER

And Stacie loves both Bens

STORYTELLER SLOANE

She's sarcastic

STORYTELLER JOCELYN

and funny

STORYTELLER SLOANE

Skippy is a typical teenager

STORYTELLER JOCELYN

Yep, confident one minute but freaking out the next

STORYTELLER SLOANE

Don't forget the triplets

STORYTELLER GIGI

they're adorable

STORYTELLER KENNA

and naughty

MACY

I want the Chelseas as my friend

STORYTELLER JOCELYN

Midge is my favorite, my mom had one when she was little

STORYTELLER PARKER

Totally the old-fashioned one

STORYTELLER GIGI

What should I think about Rochelle

STORYTELLER SLOANE

She's in a never-ending battle with herself

STORYTELLER PARKER

She's a doll that knows what she wants

STORYTELLER SLOANE

What if fashion dolls were real?

STORYTELLER PARKER

What do you think they would do all day?

STORYTELLER SLOANE

We're about to find out.

SCENE 1: MEET THE SISTERS

(Doll House Land with

STACIE, DARBIE, CHELSEAS, SKIPPY)

STACIE

Stop looking at me like you don't know who I am...I'm the girl whose arms won't bend any further than this...

(Bends arm half-way doll-like) what... you still don't recognize me? Maybe you know my sister. She's tall, blonde, and has skin as smooth as plastic.

(music plays Darbie appears)
Here she comes now.

DARBIE, SKIPPY, CHELSEAS

(Come in with shopping bags)

STACIE

How was the mall?

SKIPPY

Exhausting but fun.

CHELSEA 1

We got another...

CHELSEAS 1, 2, 3

...unicorn stuffie

(holding matching unicorn stuffed animals)

DARBIE

And just a few accessories.

(sets down LOTS of bags and packages lowers heart sunglasses to the bridge of her nose- winks and smiles)

SISTERS SONG (Score available All Dolled Up song format score like opening song. We also have a sample recording of this song)

DARBIE: MEET MY SISTER SKIPPY

SKIPPY: I LIKE TO DRESS REAL DRIPPY

DARBIE: HER DOG IS ALWAYS YIPPY

SKIPPY: BUT MY MIND IS ALWAYS ZIPPY

DARBIE: INTRODUCING STACIE,

STACIE: MY HUMOR'S VERY DRY,

DARBIE: SHE CANNOT TELL A LIE,

STACIE: I WANT BEN TO BE MY GUY.

SISTERS, SISTERS

EVERYWHERE I GO

I GO WITH SISTERS,

SISTERS, SISTERS

SASSY, STYLED, AND BOLD.

FROM THE BEGINNING, FROM THE SAME MOLD

DARBIE: HERE ARE THE CHELSEAS CHELESEAS: WE'RE LITE AND BRIGHT

DARBIE: SOMETIMES THEY FIGHT

CHELSEAS: WE EVEN BITE! CHELSEA 2 AND 3: OWW!

(pointing to the sisters- starts counting)

CHELSEA 2

The Six

STACIE

Wrong musical

SKIPPY

The Spice Girls

STACIE

We're more sweet than spicy

DARBIE

The Golden Girls

SKIPPY

Wrong demographic

STACIE

The Original Plastics

OTHER SISTERS

(All agree shake heads say yea, that's good)

SCENE 2: MEET THE BENS

(STACIE, DARBIE, CHELSEAS, SKIPPY, BEN, FASHIONISTA BEN)

DARBIE

(Runs up to Ben)

Ben, I missed you! Where were you?

BEN

I missed you too, Darbie. I was just getting ready for the day. And Fashionista Ben couldn't decide what to wear.

(Looks at Fashionista Ben)

FASHIONISTA BEN

Guilty as charged. This is my 5th outfit change.

(removes one shirt layer very fast and throws aside)

SKIPPY

And it's only noon

DARBIE

I'm bored

BEN

Let's have a dance party

STACIE

Bens, you are both such good dancers

(Dance party song plays - Dance party with all dolls come in with a choreographed dance)

SCENE 3: THE BIG NEWS

(STACIE, DARBIE, CHELSEAS, SKIPPY, BEN, FASHIONISTA BEN, NEWSCASTERS, MADISON)

(Enter Newscasters, Dolls watch the TV)

PATTI ANN

Unbeknownst to the group, there is trouble in the Darby-Verse.

AXEL RAE

In the cut-throat world of dolls, fortunes are made or lost based on market research, sophisticated algorithms,

LILY LANE

and an 9-year-old influencer named... Madison

(All Storytellers and Newscasters

Director's Choice for solos-recording available)

DON'T MAKE MADDIE MAD SONG If you want to sell your dolls If your job matters at all If you don't want your dream to fall Don't make Maddie mad If you want to sell your toys If you want financial joy There's one kid you can't annoy - Don't make Maddie mad. Oh, 'Cause Maddie has a billion fans Who crown her as their queen Your destiny is in her hands Don't ever treat her mean. Oh, no. When your doll makes its debut When you submit for her review Is it gold or is it doo? Don't make Maddie mad She decides how dolls will do In the store or in the loo There's one thing you cannot do Don't make Maddie mad Before you speak your salutation She's made her evaluation If your latest doll creation Takes a permanent vacation Don't. (Doesn't look or acknowledge newscasters or dolls-Z Photographer videotapes)
Hi Friends and fans, it's me Madison with another Darbie video. Reviewing the latest Darbie Dolls. I give it a B... for BORING. Don't waste your money-

(hands-on hips-then throws doll over shoulder). Love you all

(blows kisses- fake happy)
Don't forget to like and subscribe

(Leaderboard with Madison's top 10 toys. Darbie's go from number 1 to number 10)

DARBIE

Boring... really?

BEN

Change the channel

(Newscaster music- mic props for newscasters)

NEWSCASTER AXEL RAE

Welcome to The Daily Doll News Show

NEWSCASTER PATTI ANN

But first a word from our sponsor

NEWSCASTER LILY LANE

Have you ever had a bad hair day? Like when the cat got you? Or when the toddler down the street decided to give you a "haircut"?

NEWSCASTER AXEL RAE

Just apply and like magic your hair will grow back.

(spraying hair with tonic)

NEWSCASTER PATTI ANN

Get to the root of the problem. Scientifically proven to keep your hair from breaking up with you.

NEWSCASTER LILY LANE

Avoid hair today gone tomorrow with Growgaine for Dolls.

NEWSCASTER PATTI ANN

Breaking news. This just in. Manufacturing of the Darbie dolls has stopped.

NEWSCASTER LILY LANE

Not enough little girls play with Darbie dolls anymore and influencer Madison just released a video to her 10 million fans telling them not to buy Darbies. Let's hear from newscaster Axel Rae.

NEWSCASTER AXEL RAE

Unless the SELL SELL Toys sees an uptick in imaginative play all production lines are told to freeze manufacturing. The CEO might discontinue the Darbie Franchise.

NEWSCASTER PATTI ANN

Dolls if you're listening. We have to form a plan. So we're not extinct.

NEWSCASTER AXEL RAE

You mean...discontinued.

NEWSCASTER PATTI ANN

Yes, discontinued. If Sparkle City... and all cities show a demand for new dolls, manufacturing will restart in time for the holiday season. Now a word from our sponsor.

NEWSCASTER LILY LANE

I scream, you scream we all scream for ...

(singing)

NEWSCASTER AXEL RAE

Plastic ice cream

(Plastic ice cream prop)

NEWSCASTER LILY LANE

It's delicious, and nutritious. Come visit The Dairy Doll.

NEWSCASTER PATTI ANN

Guaranteed not to melt in your mouth

SKIPPY

(Turns off TV)

I don't want to live in a world where our family is separated and sold to the highest bidder on eBay

(frantic/scared)

STACIE

Yeah, we will be trapped in a box that's so claustrophobic we can barely breathe

(mimes being stuck in box)

CHELSEAS

(Huddle up/hug and look at each other scared)

DARBIE

(Doll box goes over Darbie after box is in place Darbie is frozen with a big smile and doll-like posture- horror music plays)

BEN

I'll save you

(Stacie and Ben remove box and throw it)

DARBIE

Guys. We're not going to be put on a shelf like a porcelain doll. The news is always overdramatic. Relax... we should have a pool party.

SKIPPY

Okay

(all except Stacie agree)
Let's set up for the party.

(Darbie and the other sisters leave)

STACIE

(To audience)

Sometimes I just need a... break. If this is the end I need you to know a few things. I HATE the color pink... I know it's almost as shocking as my nail polish color and also Darbie can't fix everything. It's not always like...

STACIE (CONT'D)

(Said like a valley-girl)

"Hi, I'm Darbie, welcome to my dream house. Let's have a pool party".

(crazed Ha, ha, ha laugh)

pheww!

SCENE 4: PERFECT PREP GIRLS AND THE IVY LEAGUES

(Location Real-World Madison's bedroom)

(Storytellers, MADISON, IVY, PIPER, EMERALD, CASH)

STORYTELLER PARKER

Could the remaining Darbies be stuck in a four-walled pink Jail?

STORYTELLER BLAKE

aka THE BOX

(points to Doll box on stage)

STORYTELLER SLOANE

We now go inside the real-world home of Sell, Sell, Sell CEO Emerald...

STORYTELLER LAKELYN

who lives with her husband Cash and her daughter Madison.

STORYTELLER PARKER

Madison is a top Fashion Doll influencer.

STORYTELLER KENNA

Because of her mom, she reviews Darbie products before they are released in stores.

STORYTELLER BLAKE

We are in the room of Emerald's daughter Madison and her two best friends Ivy and Piper.

(Exit storytellers)

MADISON

What college do you want to go to?

IVY

I don't know, Madison. Aren't we a little young?

MADISON

Well, I'm glad you didn't say Harvard. That would be dumb. They only accept 3%... sooooo

PIPER

So that means 97% of people that apply won't get in.

MADISON

DUH

(eye roll)

TVY

We're only in third grade- how do you know everything?

MADISON

I guess I was just born smart.

(big smile-sassy-hand behind head) (EMERALD and CASH walk into their bedroom)

CASH

Hi, Maddie bear

MADISON

(Rolls eyes)

Hi, Father

EMERALD

Madison, Ivy, Piper. Did you finish all your studying? I want to make sure you get perfect grades on your...

MADISON

We're about to start.

EMERALD

Don't forget to create a business plan for your non-profit

MADISON

Fine Mother

(elongating mother) Why are you home so early?

EMERALD

We had to do some layoffs at work today. We're trying to figure out what to do with the Malibu Darbie Franchise.

CASH

Why don't you play with Malibu Darbie anymore?

(hands her a doll)

MADISON

More like Dumpster Darbie

(throws away the doll holding it by the hair and walking by a small trash can and throwing it)

DARBIE

(real-life Darbie drops and rolls into bigger trash can by the side of the stage)

PIPER AND MADISON

(Laugh)

CASH

Sweetie, you used to love Darbie Dolls

(Shakes head/sad)

(Cash and Emerald Exit)

IVY

What were your parents talking about? A non-profit?

MADISON

My mom says I have to get a "change-the-world"

(in air quotes)

kind of scholarship.

PIPER

That means we have to start on it RIGHT NOW. My college advisor says I should start my own non-profit too.

IVY

It's nice to help people.

MADISON

Yeah, I know. But the problem is you have to be at least 13 to volunteer

IVY

But we're only 9

PIPER

I guess we have to wait a few years

MADISON

What a waste

IVY

To de-stress... maybe a facemask

PIPER

Or make a TikTok video

MADISON

Yeah. Get the phone.

(Girls dancing around making a video)

SCENE 5: THE EARTHQUAKE

(STACIE, DARBIE, CHELSEAS, SKIPPY, BEN, FASHIONISTA BEN, enter later in scene MIDGE, KELLY, TADD)

DARBIE

Dumpster Darbie

(pacing)

She said I'm...garbage

CHELSEA 1

Are we

CHELSEA 2

going to be

CHELSEA 3

ok?

(Three girls trembling)

DARBIE

You're all just paranoid. Think positive! I'm having a good hair day, my lipstick color is the perfect mix of pink and red, and we have enough clothes for

(thinks about it looks up)
16.5 outfit changes every day for the next year. Life is Gucci.

(Rumbling sound effects... sounds like earthquake)

ALL DOLLS

(Dolls shake/unsteady like they are in an earthquake. Items fall to the ground.)

STACIE

What's going on?

SKIPPY

Don't panic, Skippy. Don't panic.

(talking to self- pacing)

DARBIE

I think our house is being moved

SKIPPY

To the basement!

DARBIE

To the basement!

(dramatic)

(Clothing is thrown everywhere. Other items are displaced and thrown on stage. Earthquake sound effects.)

STACIE

(Scared)
Oh no,that's bad!

SKIPPY

And half our clothes have fallen out

ALL DOLLS

Worse. Than. Bad.

BEN

This means war!

FASHIONISTA BEN

(Jumps out from under a pile of clothes out of nowhere)

No one messes with Ben and his closet.

STACIE

You look Ben-Tastic

(in love)

DARBIE

Don't get distracted. What should we do?

(asks Stacie)

STACIE

(snaps out of it)

You're right. Things could get much worse. I hear Taffy barking like crazy.

(Noise dog barking)

SKIPPY

He must have fallen out... when Madison moved our house

BEN

(a pained yelp/scream)

Ahhhh, oh no T-t-t-t-affy. He was the best dog.

STACIE

If Madison and her fans play with us again, we can tell the basement Buh-Bye.

(waves)

ALL DOLLS

Buh-Bye. Buh-Bye. Buh-Bye.

(staggered how they say Buh-Buh-wave)

DARBIE

One stellar product review could save us.

SKIPPY

And we won't be discontinued like Tadd, Kelly, Midge and so many others.

(Tad and Kelly pop out everyone's startled - they look dusty and their hair is sticking up-Sisters and Bens looked startled like they've seen a ghost) DARBIE

Tad! Kelly?! we haven't seen you since 2008. Midge it's been since like ...

MIDGE

1963

TADD

We've been here for years. When we got taken off shelves and weren't sold anymore we got ...

KELLY

thrown aside

MIDGE

and forgotten about

DARBIE

Did you make any friends?

MIDGE

Just Tadd and Kelly

DARBIE

Do you have a boyfriend?

MIDGE

(Shakes head no looking sad)

No

(she begins to sing)

ORDINARY TEENAGE GIRL SONG

Director note: Can be sung acapella-like the sample- or with background music sample for either choice

[MIDGE]I'M JUST AN ORDINARY TEENAGE GIRL WEARING BOBBY SOCKS AND CUTE PIN CURLS I'VE GOT POISE TO LOOK AT BOYS BUT THEY WON'T LOOK AT ME. GEE! I'M JUST AN ORDINARY TEENAGE GIRL LOOKING FOR AN ORDINARY TEENAGE BOY. IF I FOUND JUST ONE. I'D REALLY HAVE FUN.
[ALL DOLLS]WITH AN ORDINARY TEENAGE ORDINARY TEENAGE ORDINARY TEENAGE ORDINARY TEENAGE BOY JOY! (MIDGE LAUGHS AND SNORTS)

SCENE 6 : BEN'S IDEAS

(STACIE, DARBIE, CHELSEAS, SKIPPY, BEN, FASHIONISTA BEN, MIDGE, Z PHOTOGRAPHER)

SKIPPY

We can't let that happen to us

BEN

With muscle tone and a tan like this, I was meant to be noticed

(Flexes muscles)

STACIE

Oh, Ben

(in love- hand on muscle)

that's so true

FASHIONISTA BEN

So... what's the plan?

BEN

I have ideas

DARBIE

Okay, spill

BEN

First, we gather up all the paper in the house- make signs and start picketing.

DARBIE

Picketing?

BEN

Like what people do to get votes. Or, to change a law.

DARBIE

(Annoyed)

Ben, I know what picketing is, but how is that going to help?

SKIPPY

We're trying to get little girls to play with us again, I'm not sure picketing should be part of the plan.

BEN

Ben, what if we jump in the toilet and get them to fish us out?

FASHIONISTA BEN

Great idea, Ben. That will get them to notice us.

STACIE

How brilliant

(claps)

DARBIE

EWWWWWWW

SKIPPY

That's a great way to get them NOT to play with us!

CHELSEA 1

And what if we get...

CHELSEA 1-3

flushed!

(dramatic and scared holding hands)

MIDGE

Let's make a list of all the reasons that stop them from playing with dolls

BEN

I've got it

FASHIONISTA BEN

(Points to Ben)

He's got it

BEN

Wait for it...

(Everyone stares and Ben starts brushing his hair)

BEN (CONT'D)

(while brushing hair)

1, 2, 3,

(looks in the mirror)

8, 11

(counting the brushes)

Oh, yeah. Here it is... a way to get more girls to play with dolls is Darbie could have a different

(said slowly)

career path.

FASHIONISTA BEN

Yeah, that could work

STACIE

Darbie has already done everything. She's been an astronaut.

(Director's note: DARBIE, FASHIONISTA BEN, and BEN act in between each career-next part is at a very fast speed-ask if you have questions it's a bit hard to communicate we have a video sample)

FASHIONISTA BEN

Houston we have a problem

STACIE

Teacher

DARBIE

Can you tell me what this says?

(points to letters)

BEN

I can now read words

STACIE

CEO

DARBIE

(power pose lift up briefcase)

STACIE

Surgeon

DARBIE

Scalpel, Peanut Butter

BEN

Peanut butter?

STACIE

Reporter

DARBIE

(mic up to Bens)

STACIE

Coach

DARBIE

Get your head in the game

STACIE

Chef

DARBIE (Chopping and singing) STACIE Pilot DARBIE (Pretending to fly an airplane) STACIE Olympic medalist DARBIE (Arm in air all clap) STACIE Dog walker DARBIE (walks both Bens) STACIE And even President of the United States ALL DOLLS EXCEPT DARBIE I pledge allegiance to the flag of the United States of Darbie BEN Okay I get it FASHIONISTA BEN But maybe she could be a zookeeper SKIPPY Been there BEN A fashion designer

DARBIE Done that

FASHIONISTA BEN

A Ballerina

SKIPPY Since 1961 to like now

BEN

Okay I've got it she could be a ... Teacher

DARBIE

Really, Ben

(annoyed-arms crossed)

MIDGE

We're not getting anywhere with this

ALL DOLLS

(fighting say things like you're wrong- we should do this- we're all going to be forgotten... Cheleas sticking tongues out at each other and hiding behind taller dolls popping head out and chasing after each other)(Everyone starts fighting- back and forth come Ben- that's a terrible idea- why doesn't anyone listen to me... back and forth)(Z pops out of nowhere starts taking photos- fighting stops as they fake smile and pose)

Z PHOTOGRAPHER

Okay time for your close-up - look happy and squeeze in

ALL DOLLS

(All dolls stop fighting immediately and smile like everything is perfect)

MIDGE

Wait, who is she?

STACIE

Meet Z, she's our personal brand photographer.

SKIPPY

She works part-time for the Kardashian dolls.

MIDGE

Golly gee, who are the Kar Flash-ian dolls?

SKIPPY

Midge, You've missed a lot

(chuckles)

MIDGE

Like what?

(snorts and laughs)

DARBIE

Well, we do text messages now and write out our conversations

SKIPPY

Instead of calling each other

MIDGE

Like the telegraph? But I bet you watch movies on enormous screens now. So much bigger than in the 60s.

STACIE

Actually...we watch movies on our phones.

CHELSEA 1

Little baby screens

(making voice tiny)

MIDGE

Hmmm

DARBIE

But we do have Bitcoin, self-driving cars, and Biore Face Strips.

(Shows the Huge Biore Face Strip package)

MIDGE

Do tell me more about the face strips...

(Skippy whispers and shows her the box explaining the face strips)

DARBIE

Oh no

(under her breath) (Smiles at Midge-then thinks of the future and looks nervous and starts pacing-hand to head like she has a headache and lets out a deep breath)

BEN

Darbie, Everything is gonna be fine.

(says in a nervous voice)

FASHIONISTA BEN

I'm fine, you're fine, we're all going to be fine

(sounds very nervous-sing songy-verge of crying-voice cracks)

DARBIE

Only one thing will make me feel better ...

ALL

Outfit change!

(Music plays. Everyone gathers around sisters to block them. Darbie, Skippy and Stacie have cast unzip larger dress to reveal skirt and top underneath-then matching pink letterman jackets are placed onto all three by the cast. Dolls grab pom poms)

SCENE 7: ROCHELLE AND CHEERLEADING

(ALL DOLLS, Sample video and audio avaliable)

(Said to a beat)

ROCHELLE

Darbie Dolly in the flesh

RYAN

Here comes the plastic squad - you should

ROCHELLE

Shush up Brother (or sister depending)

RYAN

Sorry Sister

REAGAN

Look who's with her - Oh my gosh

DARBIE

Thanks for the theme song Rochelle but I'm good I already have themed cheer.

(Cheer)

SKIPPY

Ready

ALL (EXCEPT DARBIE)

okay

DARBIE

Hold up wait minute let's put some spirit in it

(All Dolls except Reagan, Rochelle and Ryan create the letters with their pom-poms as a team)

BOTH BENS

Give me D

EVERYONE EXCEPT BEN'S

D, You've got your D you've got your D

(Dolls form the letter D with Pom Poms)

BOTH BENS

Give me an A

EVERYONE EXCEPT BENS

A, You've got you're A you've got your A

(Dolls form the letter A with Pom Poms)

BENS

Give me an R

EVERYONE EXCEPT BENS

R, You've got you're R you've got your R

ROCHELLE

(annoyed with a bad attitude arms crossed-walks through the middle of cheerleaders)

ROCHELLE (CONT'D)

B-I-E

DARBIE

We've got spirit yes we do, we've got spirit how about you!

ROCHELLE

Yeah! You have spirit, woohooo

(sarcastic)

DARBIE

Ready, okay.

ALL EXCEPT REAGAN, ROCHELLE, RYAN:

OKAY- (DO SPIRIT DANCE)

We got spirit what, what what, we've got spirit , What what what

DARBIE

Last time

Rochelle

You've got spirit yes you do

(sarcastic doing jazz hands and clapping), but we've got fashion, how bout you?

(points at Darbie)

REAGAN

It looks like Valentine's Day exploded in here

(gesturing to all doll's clothing)

ROCHELLE

Yeah, light-pink called...and said they want pantone color 230 back

RYAN, REAGAN, AND ROCHELLE (CONT'D)

(All laugh)

RYAN

Burn

(RYAN, REAGAN, and ROCHELLE sing to DARBIE. Optional background dancers can appear behind)

FRENEMY SONG

(Demo voice version)

Rochelle: I'm not your sister, sister

RYAN: I'M NOT YOUR FRIEND

REAGAN: I'M NOT THE GIRL YOU COUNT ON

ALL: UNTIL THE END

ALL: I'M JUST YOUR FRENEMY - I'M JUST YOUR FRENEMY

I'M JUST YOUR FRENEMY - I'M JUST YOUR FRENEMY

RYAN: AND THAT'S ALL...(HOLD NOTE)
ROCHELLE: THAT'S ALL...(HOLD NOTE)
REAGAN: THAT'S ALL...(HOLD NOTE)

ALL: I'LL EVER BE.

YOUR FRENEMY!

ROCHELLE: I'LL HELP YOU WITH YOUR MAKEUP

RYAN: AND SAY THAT YOU'RE THE GOAT

REAGAN: BUT WHEN IT'S TIME FOR PROM QUEEN,

ALL: YOU WON'T GET MY VOTE.

ALL: I'M JUST YOUR FRENEMY - I'M JUST YOUR FRENEMY

I'M JUST YOUR FRENEMY - I'M JUST YOUR FRENEMY

RYAN: AND THAT'S ALL...(HOLD NOTE)
ROCHELLE: THAT'S ALL...(HOLD NOTE)
REAGAN: THAT'S ALL...(HOLD NOTE)

ALL: I'LL EVER BE.

YOUR FRENEMY!

ROCHELLE: I'LL DO YOU A FAVOR RYAN: AND DRIVE YOU ALL AROUND.

REAGAN: BUT I'LL STEAL YOUR BOYFRIEND

ALL: THE MOMENT YOU LEAVE TOWN.

ALL: I'M JUST YOUR FRENEMY - I'M JUST YOUR FRENEMY

I'M JUST YOUR FRENEMY - I'M JUST YOUR FRENEMY

RYAN: AND THAT'S ALL...(HOLD NOTE)
ROCHELLE: THAT'S ALL...(HOLD NOTE)
REAGAN: THAT'S ALL...(HOLD NOTE)

ALL: I'LL EVER BE.

YOUR FRENEMY!

ROCHELLE: "FRIEND" IS MUCH TOO SWEET A WORD.

RYAN: AND "ENEMY" - TOO MEAN.

REAGAN: PUT BOTH WORDS TOGETHER, ALL: I'M SOMETHING IN BETWEEN.

ALL: I'M JUST YOUR FRENEMY - I'M JUST YOUR FRENEMY

I'M JUST YOUR FRENEMY - I'M JUST YOUR FRENEMY

RYAN: AND THAT'S ALL...(HOLD NOTE)
ROCHELLE: THAT'S ALL...(HOLD NOTE)
REAGAN: THAT'S ALL...(HOLD NOTE)

ALL: I'LL EVER BE.

YOUR FRENEMY...

(RYAN, REAGAN, and ROCHELLE get in a verbal fight and RYAN and REAGAN storm offstage angry)

SCENE 8: MODEL CHALLENGE FACEOFF

(Doll world, Runway fashion)

(All Dolls)

DARBIE

(exhale)

We have to work together

ROCHELLE:

How can I trust you? I doubt you even know the difference between plaid and gingham.

(angry stare at DARBIE) (everyone gasps as if this is the worst insult)

DARBIE

The difference is quintessential to fashion. Let me break it down for you.

(Talks fast, smart, and authoritative)
Plaids feature vertical and horizontal stripes whereas
gingham has squares arranged in rows and columns. The word
plaid comes from the Scottish term meaning "blanket".
Furthermore, plaids often appear on wool that is thicker and
gingham is printed on lightweight fabric.

(Slow it back down)
This doll knows her fashion.

(dolls clap)

ROCHELLE

Well bless your heart.

(T in heart is over-enunciated)

Fine, you understand. But I totes have better ideas. This isn't a cas you al

(casual pronounced strange) situation... this is serious.

(overdramatic facial expression)

BEN

What if you challenge each other to a duel?

RYAN

You mean a catwalk Face-Off? The winner will act as project manager.

STACIE

Freeze. Someone's coming downstairs.

(Everyone except Kelly, Tadd, and Stacie freeze)

KELLY AND TADD AND STACIE (CONT'D)

(freeze in 3 quick different positions like they are doing the robot- then freeze- Stacie keeps almost seeing them do the robot)(Whole cast except Stacie freezes-Stacie addresses the audience)

STACIE (CONT'D)

Yeah, no ones coming. I just had to talk to you. Does the fate of our species really come down to a model challenge? We're doomed.

(Rolls eyes)(addresses dolls)

False alarm everyone.

(extra cheery fake smile- waves hand in air)

ALL DOLLS

(Everyone exhales and starts moving)

MIDGE

Catwalk Face-Off, Old Fashioned rules: Walk, pose, and score

STACIE

How exciting

(winks at audience-fake encouraging)

BEN

Scores are tabulated at the end

DARBIE

I've got this

(Music starts music fast paced without words)

Z PHOTOGRAPHER

(Takes photos throughout runway challenge)

(Director note: this scene can be cut or extended per director's choice will run from 2-6 minutes depending on director)

BEN

Raggedy Ann Doll

DARBIE

(Walks like a rag doll- floppy-hands out-looks like she wants a hug)

ROCHELLE

(Walks like a rag doll- floppy-hands out-looks like she wants a hug)

BEN

Zombie

DARBIE

(Walks, pose, impersonates a zombie)

ROCHELLE

(Walks, pose, impersonates a zombie)

BEN

Blue Steel

ALL EXCEPT DARBIE AND ROCHELLE

Orange, mocha, Frappuccino

(dolls say line while the Darbie and Rochelle pose)

KELLY

(hands Tadd a frappuccino and sips on a second one for herself)

TADD AND KELLY (CONT'D)

(jump up and down from caffeine- eye twitch super hyper both run off stage in a hyper fit)

FASHIONISTA BEN

Home Alone

DARBIE AND ROCHELLE

(hands to cheeks)

Z PHOTOGRAPHER

Work it- work it-the camera loves you

ROCHELLE

(discreetly trips Darbie when walking back from Home Alone)

DARBIE

(Stumbles a little)

FASHIONISTA BEN

Ben when he's out of hairspray and eaten a Costco sized bag of chocolate

ROCHELLE

(looks pained and hyper and jumping-touching hair)

DARBIE

(Darbie walks halfway then gives a puzzled look to the chocolate prompt like she doesn't know how to complete the walk, shrugs shoulders then walks off.)(Judges put hand over the head of Darbie and everyone claps-then they put their hand over Rochelle's head and Darbie goes crazy clapping for Rochelle-Darbie shakes the hand of Rochelle)

BEN

Rochelle is our winner.

(Ben puts arm in the air like a boxer winner)

ROCHELLE

My name is Rochelle

(Rolls her R)

STACIE

Okay Rochelle

(rolls R dramatically)

How do you want to handle this last Darbie on earth situation?

ROCHELLE

I have a stellar plan, come here.

(motions to everyone)

(All dolls gather around Rochelle and whispers. Rochelle looks authoritative giving directions. All in whispers)

(All exit stage except Darbie, Stacie, and Skippy) (Rochelle disagrees with her sisters and they storm off)

SCENE 9: SISTER TALK

(Stacie, Darbie, Skippy)

SKIPPY

Like, why did you let Rochelle win?

STACIE

She's so mean to you... why did you let her get away with it?

DARBIE

I didn't let her get away with anything. The thing is, Rochelle has a tough life. She's always in competition with her twin. She's just one half...of a whole.

SKIPPY

She just always wants more attention?

(questioning like she's not sure if she's right)

DARBIE

Precisely. I just trigger her need to compete. It's really not about me... it's about her.

STACIE

Insightful

DARBIE

She's a textbook narcissist with passive-aggressive tendencies.

SKIPPY

When did you learn to psychoanalyze?

(surprised)

DARBIE

At Stanford of course.

(pause)

Corporate sent me to get my phD in psychology but then decided it wasn't a "marketable" Darbie brand. Oh, and I can tell all about someone's personality based on their lipstick color choice...

(Cocks head, thinking)

Don't trust anyone that wears mauve or tangerine shades.

(serious)

SKIPPY

Yeah, tangerine is NOT the new pink

STACIE

Darbs, what other professions don't we know about?

DARBIE

I am also a trained truck driver, hedge fund manager, and plumber but...

(sisters start walking off stage)

SKIPPY

Yeah, not really on brand...

DARBIE

Exactly

(Skippy and Stacie exit)

ALL DOLLED UP-NO WHERE TO GO SONG

DARBIE: TAKE A LOOK, I'M REAL STRESSED

CURL MY LASHES, I'M A MESS

PAINT MY NAILS, MAKE THEM SHINE

THERE'S NO TROUBLE, I CAN'T MAKE MINE

MY SKIN IS PERFECT, BUT WHO CARES

I'LL BE READY, FOR THE END OF THE WORLD (NOT SINGING JUST

SAYING- DRAMATIC VERGE OF CRYING)

CHOOSE A DRESS, THAT MAKES ME CRY

OH NO, THIS IS BAD WE'RE ALL GOING TO DIE

ALL DOLLED UP AND NOWHERE TO GO

ALL DOLLED UP - HERE I GO!

Enter Ben

BEN: ARE YOU OKAY?

DARBIE: NO, I FEEL LIKE EVERYONE'S COUNTING ON ME TO SAVE

THE DARBIE FRANCHISE BUT I DON'T KNOW HOW

BEN: RELAX, WE SHOULDN'T LET A LITTLE THING LIKE POSSIBLE

TOTAL ANNIHILATION OF THE DARBIE UNIVERSE GET US DOWN

BEN: YOU'RE THE GIRL WHO ALWAYS PREVAILS, WHATEVER THE

PROBLEM ENTAILS... YOU'RE NOT ALONE, I'LL ALWAYS BE THERE.

YOU'LL ALWAYS HAVE YOUR FAMILY AND THEY ALWAYS WILL CARE. MADISON IS HARD. BUT WE'LL HIT BAD EVEN HARDER BUT SITTING 'ROUND AND SULKING IS A MAJOR NON-STARTER. SO LET'S RUN. I'VE GOT A GREAT PLAN. COME ALONG WITH ME, WE'LL ALL JOIN THE CLAN.

BEN AND DARBIE: ALL DOLLED UP AND READY TO GO. ALL DOLLED UP AND HERE I GO. GO-OOO-OOOO. ALL DOLLED UP AND READY TO GO. HERE I

BEN: GO GO GO GO. AHHH (IN LOVE)

SCENE 10: PRINCESS GENES

(Sparkle City real world MADISON, IVY, PIPER)

IVY

(puts on a crown)

MADISON

My mom says, pretending to be a princess isn't realistic

IVY

What do you mean?

MADISON

Well... the chance of being an actual princess are like 1 in sixty-five million/trillion/bazillion.

PIPER

Yeah, the chances of being hit by an asteroid are higher

(looking at nails)

MADISON

So she doesn't understand why I would play princess

IVY

(Looks ashamed and sad)

PIPER

Facts. We don't even have the royalty gene

MADISON

If you want to live up to your name and get into the Ivy leagues, you should stop being so... basic.

IVY

(Looks sad and runs off)

SCENE 11: SPOILED ROTTEN

(Real world, MADISON, IVY, PIPER)

SPOILED ROTTEN

Do Re Me

(Madison, Ivy, Piper)
(Madison carried in by Cash
and Emerald)

Madison: Why do they say I'm spoiled rotten?

MADISON: DO, RE, MI

DO, RE, MI ME, ME, ME

IT'S ALL ABOUT...

ALL: ME!

(INSTRUMENTAL INTRO)

MADISON: AT LUNCH, WHO IS THE FIRST IN LINE?

IVY & PIPER: ME, ME, ME

MADISON: IN VOLLEYBALL, WHO GETS TO SHINE?

IVY & PIPER: ME, ME, ME

MADISON: WHAT I WANT, I ALWAYS GET.

IVY & PIPER: SHE IS EVERY TEACHER'S PET.

MADISON: WHEN YOU GAMBLE, ALWAYS BET

IVY & PIPER: ON ME, ME, ME

MADISON: IT'S ALL ABOUT

ALL: ME!

MADISON: WHEN CONCERT TICKETS ARE SOLD OUT,

IVY & PIPER: ME, ME, ME

MADISON: THEY WILL NEVER GO WITHOUT

IVY & PIPER: ME, ME, ME

MADISON: I CAN TANTRUM, I CAN SHOUT.

IVY & PIPER: SHE CAN DO THE PERFECT POUT!

MADISON: (MOMMY OR DADDY) MAKES IT ALL WORK OUT

IVY & PIPER: FOR ME, ME, ME

MADISON: IT'S ALL ABOUT ALL: ME!(INSTRUMENTAL)

MADISON: WHEN THINGS GO BAD, WHO IS TO BLAME?

IVY: NOT SHE MADISON: NOT ME PIPER: NOT WE

MADISON: WHO PLAYS FAIR IN EVERY GAME?

IVY: NOT SHE MADISON: NOT ME PIPER: NOT WE

MADISON: IF I SHOULD STEP UPON YOUR TOES,

IVY & PIPER: WELL, THAT'S JUST THE WAY THAT IT GOES.

MADISON: WHEN I SING, MY EVERY NOTE IS

IVY & PIPER: ME, ME, ME MADISON: IT'S ALL ABOUT

ALL: ME!

SCENE 12: BE BRAVE

(Dream House ROCHELLE, CHELSEAS, STACIE, TADD, BENS, MIDGE, DARBIE)

ROCHELLE

Huddle up

(dolls come together)

The next series of tasks will break down Madison's adult tendencies and rebuild her as a kid again.

TADD

So she likes dolls again?

STACIE

And give Darbies a good online review?

BEN

And manufacturing restarts?

ROCHELLE

Duh... yes, yes, and also yes. It's T-I-M-E for Operation Darbie Domination

CHELSEA 1

I'm scared

DARBIE

We need to be brave

STACIE

Like wearing blue eyeshadow brave

DARBIE

Braver

TADD

Like wearing plaids and stripes together brave?

BENS

NOOOO- AHHH

(act like someone dies overdramatic)

DARBIE

Closer

MIDGE

Braver than wearing white on someone else's wedding day?

DARBIE

Yes, exactly

ALL

(Gasps overreaction)

MIDGE

Oh my stars

(hand to head like she's going to faint)

SCENE 13: FACE MASK PROBLEMS

(ROCHELLE, CHELSEAS, IVY, PIPER, MADISON. Enter into the real world. Madison's bedroom. Scene involves physical acting and actions)

ROCHELLE

Done right this will embarrass and humiliate. Darbie Juniors let's go in

CHELSEA 1

It's Chelsea with an I

CHELSEA 2

It's Chelsea with a Y

CHELSEA 3

It's Chelsea with a double E

ROCHELLE

Fine, baby Darbies. Let's go.

CHELSEAS

(Girls take out a Vanilla frosting jar and switch out facemask for frosting- hardened pre-done facemask is ready and Chelseas puts on pink ski masks and tip-toe with mask and places on girl's dresser-music plays, dolls sneak out)

IVY

My favorite, thanks for bringing a new face mask

PIPER

I didn't

MADISON

Mine

(Grabs facemask-Puts facemask on- takes off after a few seconds - red stickers/dots appear to show skin irritation Maddison starts itching)

TVY

Umm, your face (points at Madison's face)

PIPER

Uhhhh

(makes a funny expression looking at Madison)

MADISON

(Pulls mirror out and runs off stage screaming-removes stickers backstage)

IVY

There goes my favorite hobby

(Ivy and Madison walk off stage)

SCENE 14: SPLISH SPLASH

(Real world, BEN, FASHIONISTA BEN, AND TADD come in scuba gear- facemask, other dolls enter late scene)

BEN

It's time for Phase 2 Bens go rogue secret mission

ROCHELLE

What does that mean? I did NOT plan this.

(holding her clipboard with the mission other hand goes on hip)

FASHIONISTA BEN

You'll see

TADD

It's dangerous

(holding map of house showing Bens the route)

BEN

Darbie, if I don't make it back- know that I love you

(yells it off stage)

DARBIE

(off stage)

Ben, I love you more

BEN

No, I love you more

FASHIONISTA BEN

Come on.

(Motions they have to go)

BEN

I need a minute.

(looks at Tadd)

Tadd, my long lost, discount bin, not as good looking as me... little brother. I have so much left to teach you. If anything happens to me, never forget the best advice I was ever given.

(pause - looks like he is thinking of something profound)

An outfit without accessories is like a cake without frosting.

(wipes a tear from his eye and places a hat/or accessory onto Tadd)

FASHIONISTA BEN

It's time

(sounds like a superhero with a deep voice-super hero music)

(Ben, Rochelle, Fashionista Ben, Tadd exit stage)

(White sheet is up with a toilet cut out or training toilet showing in a shadow Ben dolls jumping in- sound effect of water plunking down or can show the toilet itself. Actual doll is used so you see the silhouette of each doll jump in)

IVY

Maddie-why are there Ben Dolls in the toilet?

MADISON

What?!

PIPER

Were you playing pool party in the toilet? Ewwww

IVY

Yuck.

(plugs nose)

Are you okay?

(Bens and Tadd reenter off to the side of the stage all wet)

BEN

It worked!

(high 5s others- then brushes off hands after thinking about the toilet water-disgusted face. Dolls go backstage and spray their hair with water to look wet)

FASHIONISTA BEN

We embarrassed her big time

TADD

The sacrifice was worth it... but super cringey

(making a yes motion with arms)

ROCHELLE

Wait, wasn't the goal to get her to play with us? It clearly DIDN'T work.

(Other dolls enter)

BEN

We make a good team. Right?

(motions to other dolls)

STACIE

Yes, we do.

(turns to look at Rochelle)

Rochelle?

ROCHELLE

I guess.

(small smile as she rolls her eyes)

SCENE 15 ALEXA AND THE CHICKEN DANCE

(DARBIE, STACIE, and SKIPPY sneak in plug in and press buttons-mess with the computer and whisper as they upload a video, dolls exit then MADISON, IVY, PIPER ENTER)

MADISON

Hey Alexa, upload the latest influencer video

ALEXA

(Said off stage voice only, computer-sounding voice)
Uploading video of Madison doing the chicken dance with
broccoli in her teeth

IVY AND PIPER

(Does the chicken dance flaps arms-quick-laughing)

MADISON

Alexa Stop Uploading- stop uploading

(screaming)

PIPER

You really should turn your webcam off

IVY

I'm sure no one saw it

MADISON

(frantic)

Alexa, how many views?

ALEXA

More views than the number of kids at Perfect Prep. More views than the number of people at the last superbowl. More views than...

MADISON

Stop...Stop I'm humiliated

IVY

Don't worry not all your videos can be fire

(tries to comfort Madison hand on shoulder)

PIPER

I guess we're off TikTok for a while

(Madison crying-Piper and Ivy Exit. Parents enter.)

EMERALD

Are you okay?

MADISON

(dries her tears)

No, I'm not. I ummm...everyone saw me do embarrassing things.

(EMERALD and CASH enter)

EMERALD

What happened?

MADISON

It was dolls in the toilet...then the chicken dance of me online, and my skin got a rash from the face mask... I'm just... I'm just...

EMERALD

...a kid. You're just a kid.

CASH

You don't have to have everything figured out.

SCENE 16: THE PARTY

(Sparkle City Madison's House CASH, EMERALD, IVY, PIPER. MADISON, MACY)

CASH

It seems like Madison is having some kind of breakdown

EMERALD

(rubs her temples looks sad and stressed)
I want her to be a high achiever, but I think I pushed her too much.

CASH

Doesn't happiness count for something?

EMERALD

Yes

(shakes head)

(Walks into Madison's room)

EMERALD (CONT'D)

Sweetie, if you could help us out

MADISON

I don't want to.

CASH

Maddie bear, it would be a huge favor.

MADISON

What?

EMERALD

We need you to play with one of the younger kids

CASH

During our work dinner

MADISON

(annoyed-gives mom a dirty look)

MADISON (CONT'D)

Really?

EMERALD

She's down in the basement looking at some of your toys

CASH

If you could go meet her

MADISON

I quess...I have nothing else to do.

(Madison meets little girl and Madison waves at her)

LITTLE GIRL MACY

Hi, I'm Macy

(Macy gives Madison a shy wave)

MADISON

I'm Maddie.

LITTLE GIRL MACY

I like to color, go outside, and of course... play Darbie dolls.

(Picks up a doll and begins to play)

MADISON

That doesn't sound so bad.

LITTLE GIRL MACY

You wanna play?

MADISON

Sure. But I must have the one with the pink dress and sparkly shoes-I think it's...here

(picks up doll)

MADISON AND MACY (CONT'D)

(Both girls laugh and play with the Darbie dolls within the Darbie Dreamhouse - laughing whispering and having fun-can play a slow instrumental version of Spoiled Rotten)

SCENE 17: NEW DARBIES

(Stage is split one side Sparkle City and the other side Doll Dream House)

STACIE

(looks at Rochelle)

You make a great manager. Very no nonsense.

(looks at Darbie)

And Darbie, When I feel overwhelmed, I just remind myself of who's sister I am. Until the day we melt into a plastic puddle, you will always be my best friend.

DARBIE

Me too! I love you more than shopping and stilettos.

(Stacie and Darbie hug-Other dolls enter a circle hug and join hug. All but Rochelle join in. Rochelle walks away, arms crossed. Ben motions to Rochelle to join the hug. Rochelle turns away. Still connected in circle hug dolls shuffle over to where Rochelle is standing and encourage her to join the hug. She finally joins the circle hug.)

STORYTELLER- BLAKE

Madison, Ivy, and Piper stop doing the big kid stuff..

STORYTELLER- PARKER

and start embracing childhood.

STORYTELLER-SLOANE

Madison learns that life is more than facemasks and TikTok.

STORYTELLER- PARKER

It's okay to be little.

STORYTELLER- BLAKE

Because we're only little... for a little while.

(leaderboard with Madison's top 10 toys. Darbie goes up to #1)

MACY

Hi friends and fans

(Holding phone-passes phone off)

EMERALD AND CASH

(Watch off to the side girls don't notice them)

MADISON

We're here with the new Darbie Doll prototypes

IVY

Check out Drone Darbie

PIPER

She's really fly

(laughs)(Shows the drone with Darbie attached to it)

DARBIE

(Real life Darbie 'flies' into the audience with wings on then goes off stage)

MACY

We love selfie Darbie.

IVY

She takes your pictures so you don't have to.

PIPER

How did we ever exist without her?!

MACY

If you like this video make sure to hit like and subscribe

(puts phone down)

CASH

We're really proud of you

MADISON

Why, because we have sooo many new followers?

IVY

And we invented new Darbies?

EMERALD

No. Because you're acting like kids again

(Emerald goes in for a hug with Madison and it becomes a group hug with all)

SCENE 18: IN THE NEWS

(NEWSCASTERS and DOLLS)

NEWSCASTERS PATTI ANN

In local news, Rapunzel's hair was cut off in a sneak attack last night

AXEL RAE

The perp is still unidentified and on the loose.

LILY LANE

A Go Fund Me page has been set up- in her name- to pay for a custom wig

NEWSCASTERS PATTI ANN

In National News: Potty Pollies randomly combust into flames

AXEL RAE

But then puts out their own fire when they potty

LILY LANE

Darbie Dolls production have restarted - thanks to all of your efforts- and the help of some new friends

ALL DOLLS

(cheer)

SCENE 19: CELEBRATE

(ALL CHARACTERS)

ALL DOLLS

(Dolls celebrate- cheer-hug-laugh)

DARBIE

Oh, Taffy I'm so happy we found you. Ahhh Ben...

(petting her dog)

BEN

(presenting Darbie with a pink cake) 100 years going strong

DARBIE

That went fast

FASHIONISTA BEN

If we were a book, we'd be a classic

STACIE

If we were a day of the week, we'd be Fri-day

SKIPPY

If we were an ice cream flavor, we'd be...

CHELSEAS

Pink!

DARBIE

Things are lookin' good

MIDGE

Maybe I'll find a boyfriend

FASHIONISTA BEN

I'll get a new wardrobe

ALL DOLLS

(Look at Fashionista Ben and give a dirty look)

(Ending Shows Darbie dolls in background with cake and beach balls on other side Madison and her friends and family are playing games and patty cake motions skipping having fun playing with Darbies)

(Background music playing)

STORYTELLER-SLOANE

Darbies were born into a family both blessed and cursed.

ALL DOLLS

(Darbie dolls in background with cake having fun)

STORYTELLER DAISY

They were saved by children, and then almost destroyed by them.

STORYTELLER-PARKER

Through the dolls extraordinary effort and hard work...

STORYTELLER EVERLY

they helped continue the legacy of childhood and make-believe that spanned generations.

ALL DOLLS

(In the background playing with bubbles, beach balls and having a great time)

MADISON, PIPER, IVY

(Playing with dolls on the opposite side of the stage)

STORYTELLER- BLAKE

That gives kids the power to be their own storytellers.

STORYTELLER-SLOANE

Darbie and her family have been just about everything.

STORYTELLER- PARKER But they wouldn't be much of anything...without you.

(points to kids in the audience) SONG REPRISE ALL DOLLED UP

(All characters sing and bow and the audience claps)

Definitions in order of appearance

The Six- Broadway Musical about Henry the Eighth

Extinct- a species family animals or plants have no more living members

Discontinued- a product, toy, item no longer manufactured

Porcelain doll- a breakable doll made out of porcelain

Gucci- Fancy, fashionable, excellent

Quintessential - the perfect example of something- the essence of something

Telegraph - old fashioned system for transmitting messages along a wire

Bitcoin- Digital currency

Pantone- pan means all tone indicates the exact shade of a color. Graphic designers use this to indicate an exact shade of pink for example.

GOAT-stands for Greatest of All Time

Trigger- to cause a strong emotional reaction

Passive-Aggressive- indirect expression of negative feelings

Narcissist- a person that thinks the world revolves around them

Psychoanalyze - to determine the reason someone acts the way they do

Hedge fund manager -makes investment/money decisions for their clients

Ivy Leagues - a collection of colleges that are difficult to get into with a good reputation

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
